

Rams vs. Seahawks Postgame Notes

- The Rams beat the Seahawks, 36-31.
- L.A. swept Seattle in the season series for the first time since 2015. The Rams defeated the Seahawks, 33-31, just over a month ago at CenturyLink Field in Seattle.
- -Head Coach Sean McVay is 8-2 against NFC West opponents, with his only losses coming a season ago in a Week 5 contest against Seattle and a Week 17 contest against San Francisco, in which the Rams rested their starters.
- Under Head Coach Sean McVay, the Rams are 5-0 in games following a loss in the regular season.
- QB Jared Goff completed 28 passes for 318 yards and two touchdowns for a 113.0 passer rating.
- RB Todd Gurley II rushed 16 times for 120 yards, his 16th career game with 100-plus rushing yards and 5th of the season.
- Gurley has 13 rushing touchdowns, four receiving touchdowns and three two-point conversion this season. Gurley leads the league in scoring with 108 points.
- Gurley has scored a scrimmage touchdown in 13-straight regular season games played, a franchise record.
- Gurley (318) passed Henry Ellard (312) and Tony Zendejas (312) for 15th on the Rams all-time leading scorers list.
- TE Gerald Everett hauled in his first touchdown of the season on a 10-yard pass from Goff. Marked his third touchdown of his career.
- WR Brandin Cooks registered his first rushing touchdown of the season. Marked his fourth touchdown of the season, 32nd career and second rushing touchdown of his career.
- Cooks led the team in receptions (10) and receiving yards (100).
- WR Cooper Kupp notched his 100th career reception. He became the 60th player to reach the century mark for receptions in Rams history.
- WR Robert Woods set a new single-season career high with 832 yards. He set his previous high mark last season with 781 yards in 12 games played.
- TE Tyler Higbee recorded his second touchdown of the season, fourth career.

- The last time the Rams had two different tight ends score touchdowns in a game was December, 15, 2013, when TEs Cory Harkey and Lance Kendricks each scored touchdowns.
- DT Aaron Donald sacked Seahawks QB Russell Wilson 2.5 times. Donald has 12.5 sacks this season, establishing a new single season-high. He has 51.2 career sacks.
- DT Aaron Donald (12.5) passed D'Marco Farr (11.5 in 1995) for the most sacks by a Rams DT in a single season.
- Donald has recorded 10.5 career sacks on Seahawks QB Russell Wilson.
- The Rams are 15-0 in games in which Donald has recorded a sack since Sean McVay and Wade Phillips arrived in 2017.
- OLB Dante Fowler strip-sacked Wilson and recovered the ball at the Seattle 9-yard line.
- According to press box statistics, LB Cory Littleton and NT Ndamukong Suh split the team lead in tackles with nine each.
- K Greg Zuerlein made three PATs for 202 career PATs. He is the fifth kicker in franchise history (119th kicker overall) to successfully convert 200- plus PATs dating back to 1921.
- Zuerlein converted two-of-two field goals from 35 and 37 yards.
- P Johnny Hekker punted two times for 89 yards. He placed one punt inside the 20-yard line and had a long of 55 yards.
