

Rams at Cardinals Postgame Notes

- The Rams beat the Cardinals, 31-9, and improved to 12-3 on the season.
- The 2018 Rams (5-0) are the only team still undefeated in their division. The last time an NFC team swept their division was the Green Bay Packers in 2011. The last time an NFC West team swept their division was the Arizona Cardinals in 2008 who went on to the Super Bowl.
- The 2018 Rams are only the seventh team in franchise history to reach 12 wins in a single season, joining the 1973, 1975, 1978, 1999, 2001 and 2003 Rams teams.
- The Rams (54) surpassed their 2017 total of 51 total touchdowns. The single-season franchise record for touchdowns is 67, set by the 2000 Rams.
- L.A. (373) passed the 2001 Rams (358) for the second-most first downs in a season in franchise history. The record is 380 first downs set in 2000.
- The Rams (4,508) passed the 2002 Rams (4,480) for the third-most single-season passing yards in franchise history. The Rams trail the 2001 Rams for second-most with 4,903 yards.
- QB Jared Goff completed 19-of-24 passes for 216 yards and one passing touchdown.
- Goff also registered his second rushing touchdown of the season, fourth career.
- Goff (4,489) holds the record for second-most passing yards in a single season in franchise history. He trails Kurt Warner who passed for 4,830 yards in 2001.
- QB Jared Goff (9,382) passed Pat Haden (9,296) for ninth place and Vince Ferragamo (9,376) for eighth place on the Rams all-time passing leaders list.
- WR Robert Woods tallied his first rushing touchdown of his career on a 4-yard rush.
- Woods added a second touchdown on a 39-yard pass from Goff. Woods has seven touchdowns this season (six receiving, one rushing).
- Marked Woods' fourth career game with two touchdowns.
- Woods led the team in receptions (six) and receiving yards (89).
- RB C.J. Anderson rushed 20 times for 167 yards, an 8.4-yard average, a long of 46 yards and one touchdown. Marked his second-highest rushing yard total in his career. Anderson rushed 32 times for 168 yards as a Bronco against the Chiefs (11/30/14).

- Anderson recorded his first touchdown as a Ram on a 4-yard rush. Marked his 21st rushing touchdown of his career.
- Anderson tallied his eighth career 100-yard rushing game. The last time he achieved the feat was as a Denver Bronco when he rushed 30 times for 158 yards against the Indianapolis Colts (12/14/17).
- DT Aaron Donald sacked Cardinals QB Josh Rosen three times for a total loss of 21 yards.
- Donald has 19.5 sacks this season, setting a new franchise record for most sacks in a season since sacks became an official stat in 1982. Previously, the franchise record was held by Robert Quinn with 19.0 set in 2013.
- Marked Donald's 14th career multi-sack game.
- DT Ndamukong Suh sacked Rosen for a loss of two yards. Suh has 4.5 sacks this season, 59.5 career.
- LB Cory Littleton led the team in tackles with nine (seven solo), according to press box statistics.
- P Johnny Hekker punted two times for 103 yards. He placed both punts inside the 20-yard line.
