Rams at Seahawks Postgame Notes

- The Rams beat the Seahawks, 33-31, and improved to 5-0 on the season. The Rams have won both NFC West divisional games.
- Head Coach Sean McVay has posted a 6-2 record in the NFC West through his first two seasons as a head coach.
- Dating back to Week 13 of the 2017 season, the Rams have won their last five road games, which marks the sixth time in franchise history that the team has won at least five consecutive road contests. The feat was last accomplished by the 2001 Rams who won all eight of their road matchups.
- QB Jared Goff completed 23-of-32 passes for 321 yards and one touchdown.
- Goff also had four rushes for 16 yards, including a key 2-yard rush on fourth down on the final possession of the game.
- RB Todd Gurley notched two 2-yard rushing touchdowns and one 5-yard rushing touchdown. Gurley increased his season total to 58 points.
- Gurley has scored a touchdown in eight consecutive regular season games.
- Marked Gurley's fourth career game with at least three touchdowns in a game, and his second game at CenturyLink with at least three touchdowns.
- Gurley finished the game with 22 rushes for 77 yards and four catches for 36 yards. Totaling, 26 touches for 113 yards.
- WR Robert Woods led the team in receiving yards with five for 92 yards. Woods added a long rush of 56 yards.
- WR Cooper Kupp hauled in a 6-yard touchdown pass from Goff. Kupp has five touchdowns this season and has scored in three consecutive games.
- Kupp led the team in receptions with six for 90 yards, despite missing the second half with an injury.
- G Rodger Saffold III made his 100th career start this week. Saffold has started at four different positions in his first 100 career starts - 44 at LG, 38 at LT, 13 at RG, and five at RT.
- Rookie WR KhaDarel Hodge caught his first pass as a pro for an 14-yard gain and a first down.
- DT Aaron Donald sacked Seahawks QB Russell Wilson, increasing his season total to 3.0 sacks.

- Donald passed Grant Wistrom (41.5) for seventh place on the Rams all-time sacks list. Donald currently stands at 42.0 career sacks.
- NT Ndamukong Suh sacked Wilson. Suh has 3.0 sacks this season, 54.5 career.
- LB Cory Littleton blocked a punt, his second of the season and fourth career.
- LB Mark Barron made his 2018 season debut and led the team in tackles with nine (five total).
- K Cairo Santos converted two-of-two field goals in his Rams debut.
- DB/KR Blake Countess tallied four kickoff returns for 98 yards, a 24.5-yard average and a long return of 40 yards.
