## 2020 Los Angeles Rams Postgame Notes

#### Rams Team Notes



- The Rams clinched a berth in the for the third time in four seasons under Head Coach Sean McVay.
- Following the win against against Arizona, the Rams finished the season with the NFL's top ranked defense, allowing 281.9 yards per game.
- It marks the fourth time the Rams had the league's top-ranked defense, and the first time leading the league in total defense since 1978.
- L.A. scored its fourth defensive touchdown of the season on an 84-yard interception returned for a touchdown by CB Troy Hill. The Rams are tied with the Colts for a league-best four defensive touchdowns this season. L.A. is also tied for the most defensive scores since 2012 (Kansas City, 32).
- QB **John Wolford** made his first NFL career start.
- Wolford** finished the game completing 22-of-38 passes for 231 yards, one interception and a passer rating of 61.7.
- Wolford** rushed six times for 56 yards, marking the most a Rams quarterback has rushed in a single game since the 2000 season (T. Green, 54 yards). The mark also ranks sixth among Rams quarterbacks dating back to 1948.
- Wolford** spread the ball around to seven different receivers, averaging 10.5 yards per reception, including a season-long 38-yard completion to mark a career-long reception for Akers.
- RB **Cam Akers** rushed 21 times for 34 yards. Akers hauled in four receptions for a team-high 52 yards.
- WR **Van Jefferson** hauled in four receptions for 50 yards, including a 19-yard long.
- TE **Tyler Higbee** averaged 13.7 yards per reception, finishing with 41 yards on three receptions.
- Defensively, the Rams levied 4.0 sacks on Arizona, accounting for their eighth game with 4.0 or more sacks. L.A.'s 53.0 total sacks in 2020 ranks second-best in the league.

- **Hill's** 84-yard pick six was the longest scoring defensive interception of the season and the second-longest interception return in the NFL this season. It marked Hill's third defensive score of 2020.
- CB **Jalen Ramsey** recorded five solo tackles and broke up four passes in his 75th career game.
- LB **Samson Ebukam** levied 2.0 sacks, marking his second-career multi-sack game.
- DL **Morgan Fox** posted four tackles (three solo), 1.0 sack, two TFL and one hit on the quarterback.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** posted 1.0 sack for a nine-yard loss, to finish with 10.5 total sacks on the season. Floyd ended the night forcing one fumble, two total tackles, 1.0 sack and one hit on the quarterback.
- LB **Troy Reeder** led the team's tackling effort, posting six total tackles (four solo) and one TFL.
- DL **A'Shawn Robinson** blocked an Arizona field-goal attempt in the fourth quarter. It marks the first field-goal blocked since DL Michael Brockers in 2017 (Week 13 at Arizona).
