Rams Offensive Notes



- QB **Jared Goff** finished the game completing 27-of-37 passes for 302 yards and a 96.9 passer rating.
- The Rams rushing attack by committee generated 106 yards and three rushing touchdowns.
- RB **Malcolm Brown** recorded his third career game with multi-rushing touchdowns and marks the second time to reach the feat this season. He finished the day rushing six times for 33 yards and two touchdowns.
- RB **Darrell Henderson Jr.** rushed seven times for 28 yards and 1 touchdown and hauled in one reception for 5 yards.
- RB **Cam Akers** led the team with carries with 10 rushes totaling 28 yards.
- Three receivers hauled in 50-plus yards with two explosive completions garnering 30-yards or more.
- WR **Josh Reynolds** had a career-day, hauling in eight receptions for 94 yards with a 21-yard long reception. The receptions and yards receiving are career-highs in a single game.
- TE **Tyler Higbee** averaged 20.0 yards per reception hauling in three receptions for 60 yards.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** hauled in five receptions for 50 yards (10.0 yards per reception) with a long reception of 31 yards on the Rams opening drive.
- In the first half, the Rams generated 275 yards of offense, a season high. The 275 first-half yards are the second-most yardage Seattle has given up this season in the first half. It also marks Goff's 10th career game with 200 yards or more in the first half.
- K **Kai Forbath** kicked his first field goal in SoFi Stadium on the Rams opening drive (23-yards).

Rams Defensive Notes



- DL **Morgan Fox** made his first career start.
- The Rams defense held Seattle QB Russell Wilson to a 57.0 passer rating and forced three turnovers in game for the second time this season.
- Wilson's 57.0 rating is a season low.
- The defense recorded 12 total hits on the quarterback, reaching a season-high, and ties for the most hits by a Rams defense in a single game since 2015.
- CB **Darius Williams** logged the first multi-interception game of his career, picking off Seahawks QB Russell Wilson twice, including one on a third-and-nine with 7:59 remaining in the game.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** led the defensive effort posting a career-high 3.0 sacks, one fumble recovery. Floyd tallied five tackles and five hits on the quarterback.
- OLB **Terrell Lewis** recorded his first professional sack. He finished the day with 2.0 total sacks and two tackles on the day.
- DL **Michael Brockers** posted 1.0 sack, his third sack of the season. Brockers finished the game with two tackles, one TFL and one hit on the quarterback.
- LB **Micah Kiser** led the defensive tackling effort with 12 total tackles to post his third game this season with 10-plus tackles in a single game.
- DL **Aaron Donald** levied two hits on QB Russell Wilson, totaling 35 career hits on Wilson in his career.
- With the Rams holding Seattle to only 3 points in the second half, the Rams have only allowed 3.2 points (on average) per game after making halftime adjustments. The mark is the lowest in the league.
