



RAMS POSSESS 11 PICKS IN 2023 NFL DRAFT



First Round Trades Under Snead



The 2023 NFL Draft marks the tenth time General Manager Les Snead and his staff have executed a trade in or out of the first round. Here is a look back at the previous first-round moves since Snead took over as the Los Angeles Rams general manager in 2012.

2012 NFL Draft

The Rams held the No. 2 overall selection and traded it to Washington. In that trade, the Rams acquired Washington's sixth and 39th overall selections, as well as their first-round picks in 2013 (DT Michael Brockers via Dallas) and 2014 (T Greg Robinson).

2013 NFL Draft

On the first day of the draft, the Rams executed two trades in the first round. In the first trade, the Rams moved up from their No. 16 overall selection to the Buffalo Bills' No. 8 pick to select WR Tavon Austin. In exchange, the Bills got the Rams' second-round (No. 46) and seventh-round (No. 222) picks in the deal, and swapped third-round picks to move up seven spots from their original No. 78 pick to pick No. 71.

Later in the first round of the 2013 draft, the Rams held the No. 22 overall selection (via the 2012 trade with Washington) and traded back with the Atlanta Falcons at No. 30 to select LB Alec Ogletree. The Falcons also received the Rams seventh-round pick (from New England). In exchange, the Rams received the No. 30, 92 and 198 selections.

2016 and 2017 NFL Draft

In the 2016 NFL Draft, the Rams negotiated a trade with the Tennessee Titans to receive the No. 1 overall pick (QB Jared Goff), as well as their fourth-round (No. 113 LB Nick Kwiatkoski) and sixth-round (No. 177 TE Temarrick Hemingway) selections. Tennessee received the Rams' first-round selection, two second-round picks, and a third-round pick in 2016. In the 2017 draft, the Titans received the Rams' first-round and third-round selections.

2018 NFL Draft

L.A. didn't wait around until draft night to acquire offensive fire power, as the team agreed to terms to acquire WR Brandin Cooks from the New England Patriots on April 3. The Rams received Cooks and New England's No. 136 (LB Marquis Haynes, subsequently traded) overall pick in the fourth round in exchange for the Rams' No. 23 overall pick and No. 198 overall in the sixth round in the 2018 NFL Draft.

2019 NFL Draft

On the opening night of the 2019 NFL Draft, Snead made a trade with the Atlanta Falcons, sending L.A.'s first and sixth-round selections to Atlanta in exchange for the Falcons' second- and third-round picks. L.A. eventually sent the second-round pick to New England but used Atlanta's third-round choice to draft CB David Long Jr. out of Michigan.

2020 and 2021 NFL Draft

In a blockbuster move during the 2019 campaign, Snead acquired Pro Bowl CB Jalen Ramsey from the Jacksonville Jaguars in exchange for L.A.'s 2020 and 2021 first-round selections, along with a 2021 fourth-round selection.

2022 and 2023 NFL Draft

At the start of the 2021 league year, L.A.'s trade with Detroit became official with the Rams receiving QB Matthew Stafford for QB Jared Goff and L.A.'s 2022 and 2023 first-round picks as well as their 2021 third-round pick (No. 101 CB Ifeatu Melifonwu).

Rams, you're on the clock!



The Los Angeles Rams hold 11 selections entering the 2023 NFL Draft. This marks the 87th draft in franchise history, and the 57th time drafting as the Los Angeles Rams.

General Manager Les Snead is entering his 12th draft guiding the Rams franchise. The team's 11 selections are the most picks in a draft for Rams since 2018 (11). Since 2017, the Rams are tied for third in the NFL with total draft picks (64) and first in total compensatory picks (17). The team has the second-most compensatory picks this draft (with four), behind the San Francisco 49ers who have 7.

The Rams four compensatory picks this year came from the departures of OT Austin Corbett, DL Sebastian Joseph-Day, OLB Von Miller, OLB Ogbo Okoronkwo and DB Darious Williams last year, according to the NFL. The Rams gained WR Allen Robinson II as their compensatory free agent.

Despite losses of key contributors on both sides of the ball, as well as special teams, Head Coach Sean McVay is hopeful when looking at this year's draft class. "We have at least a couple of picks inside the top 100," McVay said. "The past handful of years, we're usually looking at guys from the third round and on. It will be good. We have to make sure we hit those spots. We have to have a vision for the players we are going to onboard. Let's see if they develop into the players we want them to be."

Of the Rams' 2022 selections, DBs Cobie Durant and Derion Kendrick saw the most game action. This season Durant played 270 snaps and Kendrick played 467. Durant ranked second on the team in interceptions with three, led the NFL in interception return yards (151), and won the Carroll Rosenbloom Memorial Award which recognizes the Rams' Rookie of the Year. Kendrick started six games and ranked fifth on the Rams in total tackles among defensive backs (43).

available for questions at the conclusion of Day 2 on Friday and Day 3 on Saturday. Food and beverages will be provided. Media will be asked to valet their cars directly at the house. No live TV trucks will be permitted. Upon arrival to the house, a member of the communications team will guide media to a dedicated workplace.

LOS ANGELES RAMS DRAFT HISTORY



Rams' Rookie Honor Roll



A total of six Rams players have been awarded the NFL's Offensive or Defensive Rookie of the Year Award and each of the Rams' recipients were drafted in the first round.

In 1971, LB Isiah Robertson became the first Rams rookie in franchise history to win Defensive Rookie of the Year, and the fifth NFL player overall. The Rams other three winners came on the offensive side of the ball and featured Hall of Fame running backs Eric Dickerson (1983), Jerome Bettis (1993), and QB Sam Bradford (2010).

With the 13th overall pick in 2014 and the 10th overall pick in 2015, the Rams secured back-to-back Rookie of the Year winners in DT Aaron Donald and RB Todd Gurley, respectively. Los Angeles is the first NFL team to garner consecutive Rookie of the Years since the Carolina Panthers did so in 2011-12 (QB Cam Newton, 2011 OROY and LB Luke Kuechly, 2012 DROY).

Rams' Draft Picks By School



Since 1937, the Rams have drafted players from 298 different schools. The Rams have selected 15 or more players from 22 different schools, with schools such as UCLA, Washington and USC leading the way. UCLA ranks first among Rams' draft choices, providing the team with 45 selections all-time. After two draft picks a season ago from Washington, the Huskies are second on the list with 40 picks.

The 2023 NFL Draft marks the 87th draft for the Rams franchise dating back 1937, which was the second-ever NFL Draft. The team has not had a first-round selection in only 13 of those drafts. The last time the team selected in the first round was in 2016 (QB Jared Goff, first overall).

The seasons following a draft in which the team didn't make a selection in the first round, the Rams have won at least 10 games on eight different occasions (1967, 1968, 1973, 1984, 2017, 2018, 2020, 2021), including five seasons where the Rams claimed the NFC West title (1967, 1973, 2017, 2018, 2021), and one Super Bowl title in 2021.

Draft Day in L.A.



The Rams' draft classes of 1946 and 2016 proved to be memorable ones, and each marked a new chapter for the team after moving to Los Angeles.

The 1946 NFL Draft included historical milestone selections of halfback Kenny Washington and defensive end Woody Strode, the first African-American players in the modern NFL, one year before Jackie Robinson broke the baseball color barrier with the Brooklyn Dodgers.

In the 2016 NFL Draft, the Rams made a blockbuster trade to acquire the No. 1 overall pick to select QB Jared Goff, who went on to earn consecutive Pro Bowls following the 2017 and 2018 seasons.

The Rams' selections include 10 Hall of Famers: QB Norm Van Brocklin (1949), DE Andy Robustelli (1951), LB Les Richter (1954), DE Deacon Jones (1961), DT Merlin Olsen (1962), G Tom Mack (1966), DE Jack Youngblood (1971), OT Jackie Slater (1976), RB Eric Dickerson (1983), OT Orlando Pace (1997) and WR Isaac Bruce (2021).
