Rams Rebound for Win in Seattle

- The Rams season high of 476 offensive yards carried them to a 26-17 win in Seattle. The Rams improve to 4-1 for the 2nd straight season. All 4 of the Rams wins this season have been against teams that made the playoffs last season.
- The win improves Head Coach **Sean McVay**'s all-time record against Seattle to 7-3 (1-0 in postseason). The Seahawks have scored 20 or fewer points in seven of those 10 games.
- DL **Aaron Donald** recorded 1.0 sack, passing DE Leonard Little for the all-time sack record in Rams franchise history. Little finished his career with 87.5 sacks and with today's sack on QB Russell Wilson, Donald now has 88.5 sacks in his career, and 14.0 of those in Donald's career have been on Wilson. That is the most Donald has against any QB in his career.

Rams Offensive Notes

- QB **Matthew Stafford** finished the game completing 25-of-37 passes for 365 yards, one TD, one interception, and a passer rating of 97.3.
- **Stafford** completed passes to seven different receivers for the second straight game - WRs **Cooper Kupp**, **Van Jefferson**, **Robert Woods**, **DeSean Jackson**, RB's **Sony Michel** and **Darrell Henderson Jr.**, and TE **Tyler Higbee**.
- WR **Robert Woods** had a team-high 12 receptions for a team-high 150 yards.
- WR **DeSean Jackson** had the longest reception of the day, a 68-yard catch in the third quarter.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** was second in receiving on the team with seven receptions for 92 yards. Kupp has five receptions every game so far this season and in every game dating back to 11/29/20 against San Francisco.
- TE **Tyler Higbee** hauled in two receptions for 14 yards and a TD.
- RB **Darrell Henderson Jr.** rushed the ball 17 times for 82 yards and one TD, which was the fourth highest in game total in his career, coming after last week's 89-yards rushing. He had a Rams season long 29-yard run, which was the third longest run of his career behind 38-yard and 40-yard rushes in 2020.
- RB **Sony Michel** tallied his first TD as a Ram on 11 carries for 37 yards. The Rams combined 118 yards rushing, which was their second highest all season after last week's 121 yards rushing against Arizona.

Rams Defensive Notes



- Coming into this game, QB Russell Wilson had been sacked 105 times since he came into the NFL. That is the most in the league since 2012. LB **Terrell Lewis** and DL **Aaron Donald** each tallied a sack to add up the sum to 107.
- LB **Troy Reeder** had his second interception on the season after a pass was deflected in the air by DB **Jalen Ramsey** on QB Russell Wilson's sixth pass of the game, intended for WR Tyler Lockett. The Rams made another interception to seal the game in the fourth quarter when DB **Nick Scott** jumped a pass thrown by QB Geno Smith.
- The Rams multiple interception game was the third game in which they forced two or more turnovers this season.
- LB **Jamir Jones** was claimed off waivers last week and active for his first game as a Los Angeles Ram. In the third quarter he blocked a punt, though it was recovered by the punter and re-punted in the same play.
- L.A.'s defense forced a punt on their opening drive. It marks the fifth straight game this season that the Rams have not allowed a score on their first defensive drive. The Rams also did not allow a first quarter score. This marks the fourth time in five games the Rams have shut out their opponent in the first quarter.
- L.A. allowed 92 rushing yards. This is the second game this season the Rams have held opponents to under 100 rushing yards.
- DL **Aaron Donald** made seven tackles (five solo) including two TFLs, three QB hits and one sack. He also had one Pass Deflection.
- LB **Terrell Lewis** posted the first sack of the day for a 12-yard loss. Lewis finished with three total tackles (one solo), one TFL, and one QB hit.
- DL **Sebastian Joesph-Day** led the tackling effort with eight total tackles (three solo).
