



# LOS ANGELES RAMS VS. ARIZONA CARDINALS **POSTGAME NOTES NOVEMBER 13, 2022**





# **RAMS OFFENSIVE NOTES**

- QB John Wolford made his first start of the season and second of his career. The first start of his career also came against the Cardinals in Week 17 on the 2020 season. Wolford is now 1-1 as a starter. He finished the game completing 24 of 36 passes for 212 yards and one touchdown. This is the ninth time this season that a Rams quarterback finished with a completion percentage above 65%. Wolford also completed four passes on five attempts for 29 yards on his first drive of the season, leading the Rams to a field goal. This was the second longest scoring drive of the season for the Rams (8:44).
- QB Bryce Perkins made his NFL debut in the first quarter. He contributed to a drive that led to a Rams field goal. Perkins finished the game with three rushes for four yards.
- WR Allen Robinson II has recorded at least one catch in all 109 career games, the second-longest active streak in the NFL behind DeAndre Hopkins (140.) He finished with four catches for 44 yards.
- RB Cam Akers led the Rams in rushing. He finished with six carries for 22 yards. This is the third time this season he's been the Rams leading rusher (Week 3 vs. Arizona and Week 5 vs. Dallas)
- TE Tyler Higbee was the Rams leading receiver with eight catches for 73 yards. This ties a season-high in yards for Higbee. His eight catches are the second most catches he has had this season.
- WR Van Jefferson scored his first touchdown of the season in the fourth quarter. He finished with three catches for 27 yards and one touchdown.
- RB Darrell Henderson Jr. registered his third touchdown of the season in the third quarter. He finished the game with six carries for 21 yards and one touchdown.



### RAMS DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The Rams defense allowed only three rushing yards in the first quarter and 26 in the first half. This is the fewest first quarter rush yards allowed this season, beating the previous best of four rushing yards allowed in Week 3 against the Cardinals. This is also the second-fewest first half rush yards allowed, falling short of the 14 rushing yards allowed in the first half of the Week 3 matchup against the Cardinals.
- LB Ernest Jones led the Rams with 10 tackles (six solo). This is his sixth game this season, and fourth in a row, with at least seven tackles.
- The Cardinals finished 5-15 on third downs for a 33.3% conversion percentage. This is the seventh game this season the Rams defense has allowed opposing offenses to a thirddown conversion percentage below 50%.
- LB Bobby Wagner and LB Leonard Floyd both picked up their third sacks each of the season. They are both tied for second on Rams in sacks.
- DB Nick Scott forced a fumble in the second quarter. This is his second forced fumble this season and of his career. He also finished with nine tackles (eight solo).
- The Cardinals rushed for a total of 78 yards. This is the seventh game this season where **the Rams defense** has allowed less than 100 yards rushing. Coming into the game, they were the top-ranked run defense according to PFF (85.9).
- The Rams had seven players with at least five tackles: LB Ernest Jones (10), DB Nick Scott (9), LB Bobby Wagner (9), DB Jalen Ramsey (6), DB Taylor Rapp (6), DT Aaron Donald (6), **DB Troy Hill** (5).

# **ADDITIONAL NOTES**



- The Rams under **Head Coach Sean McVay** are a combined 65-35. McVay is 23-14 against NFC West opponents, including postseason, and 11-2 against the Cardinals, including the postseason.
- **RB Kyren Williams** made his NFL debut in the second quarter. He finished with one carry for nine yards and three catches for 30 yards.
- LT Ty Nsekhe made his first start of the season, filling in at left tackle for the injured OL Alaric Jackson.
- TE Brycen Hopkins caught his first pass of the season in the fourth quarter for 11 yards.
- **DB Jalen Ramsey** played in his 100th career regular season game. Since being drafted in 2016, Ramsey has played 51 games with the Jacksonville Jaguars and 49 games with the Los Angeles Rams. In his career, Ramsey has registered 408 tackles (346 solo), 66 breakups, and 16 interceptions.
- **LB Bobby Wagner** finished the game with nine tackles (four solo). This is his seventh game this season with at least seven tackles.
- The Rams defense has not allowed more than 300-passing yards in a game this season. They also rank second best in the NFL in opponent red zone touchdowns, allowing only 11 this season.
- DB Russ Yeast made his first career tackle in the third quarter.
- WR Lance McCutcheon made his NFL debut in the second quarter.
- DT Bobby Brown III made his season debut this week. He finished the game with one tackle.
- **K Matt Gay** went 2/2 on extra points and 1/1 on field goals. On the season, Gay is 13/14 on field goals and 16/16 on extra points.
